

# Program Director, Family and Community Medicine

Northwestern Medicine is seeking a Family Medicine Program Director to lead the development and implementation of a new 8-8-8 Family Medicine Residency program in Geneva, Illinois, based at Northwestern Delnor Hospital. This is an opportunity for an experienced, enthusiastic leader to build a program with the support of an extensive network of colleagues.

The ideal candidate must be certified by the American Board of Family Medicine, have or be qualified for an Illinois Medical License, and have at least five years of clinical experience with a preference for three years as a core faculty member in an ACGME accredited family medicine residency. Additionally, the candidate should demonstrate strong administrative, communication, and team-building ability.

Candidates with recent scholarly activity, participation in national or regional scientific societies and a track record of leadership responsibilities are encouraged to apply. The Program Director will report to the Chair of Family and Community Medicine at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine as well as the Northwestern McGaw Designated Institutional Official. Academic rank and salary will be commensurate with credentials and experience.
