**Title: Secondary Analysis of Obesity Medicine Training in US Family Medicine Residency Programs**

**Background:** Obesity is a common chronic condition where the prevalence has doubled in adults and quadrupled in adolescents worldwide since the 1990's. Obesity is a leading risk factor for countless chronic conditions treated in primary care. The purpose of this secondary analysis is to better assess the readiness of graduating family medicine physicians from U.S. residency programs providing obesity care.

**Method:** Performed a secondary analysis to review survey questions regarding the topic of obesity conducted by the Council of Academic Family Medicine Educational Research Alliance (CERA). Survey answer data was collected from 04/13/22 - 05/16/22. The survey contained a qualifying question to remove programs that did not have three resident classes.
